



Your Privacy

- Mater respects the privacy of your health information and complies with the Privacy Act and the National Privacy Principles which govern the collection, use and disclosure of personal information.
- We collect personal information from and about you in order to provide you with the highest quality health care.
- We require your consent to share information about you unless we are required or authorised by law to share your information, for example, with other health care providers if it is necessary for your treatment or other agencies such as Centrelink.
- You have a right to access the personal information we hold about you and to request corrections to any information you believe is incorrect, except in certain circumstances in accordance with the Privacy Act and National Privacy Principles.

Mater's Privacy Coordinator is available to assist you with all requests for access to your personal information.



Role of the Privacy Coordinator:

- To receive and manage all requests for access to health information
- To manage requests for correction of information held by Mater Health Services
- Assist staff and patients with privacy related enquiries
- To facilitate and promote best practice in relation to information privacy
